

## **TEXTILE TRAINING INSTITUTES MANAGEMENT BOARD (TTIMB)**

- ❖ **After inception of MINTEX in 2004, all textile related EDF funded institute were placed under administrative control of MINTEX.**
- ❖ **After reviewing the present conditions of these institutes, MINTEX came to the conclusion that there is a need to revamp and upgrade these institutes through:**
  - ❖ **Purchase of new machinery and equipment.**
  - ❖ **Hiring of permanent faculty.**
  - ❖ **Affiliation with other institutions for quality, technical and managerial education.**
  - ❖ **Training of faculty and scholarship to the students**
- ❖ **Hence it was decided to constitute a common management board for all textile institutes.**
- ❖ **Textile Training institute management board (TTIMB) was notified on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2008 with Secretary MINTEX as Chairman, with representation from Government , academia and private sector and TCO as secretariat.**
- ❖ **Board is monitoring the performance of the Institutes by circulating standard formats, on monthly & annually basis.**

TTIMB has convened four meetings and has taken initiatives as under:-

- ❖ Course designing, bench marking and standardization of the syllabus/courses and duration of training.
- ❖ Financial support for new equipment, premises, hiring of professional faculty and accreditation, funded from EDF or any International Agencies.
- ❖ Update the training mechanism of all the textile Institutes; Training of trainers; and award of Scholarships to the deserving students.
- ❖ Capacity building of training institutes.
- ❖ Institutes have been disbursed funds totaling Rs.4.302 Million during 2008
- ❖ Monitoring of expenditure, audit of accounts and situation analysis is in progress.
- ❖ Reconstitution of Managing Committees of all the institutes, merger of institutes, relocation of institutes, affiliation of graduate courses with renowned universities, standardization of courses is in process.
