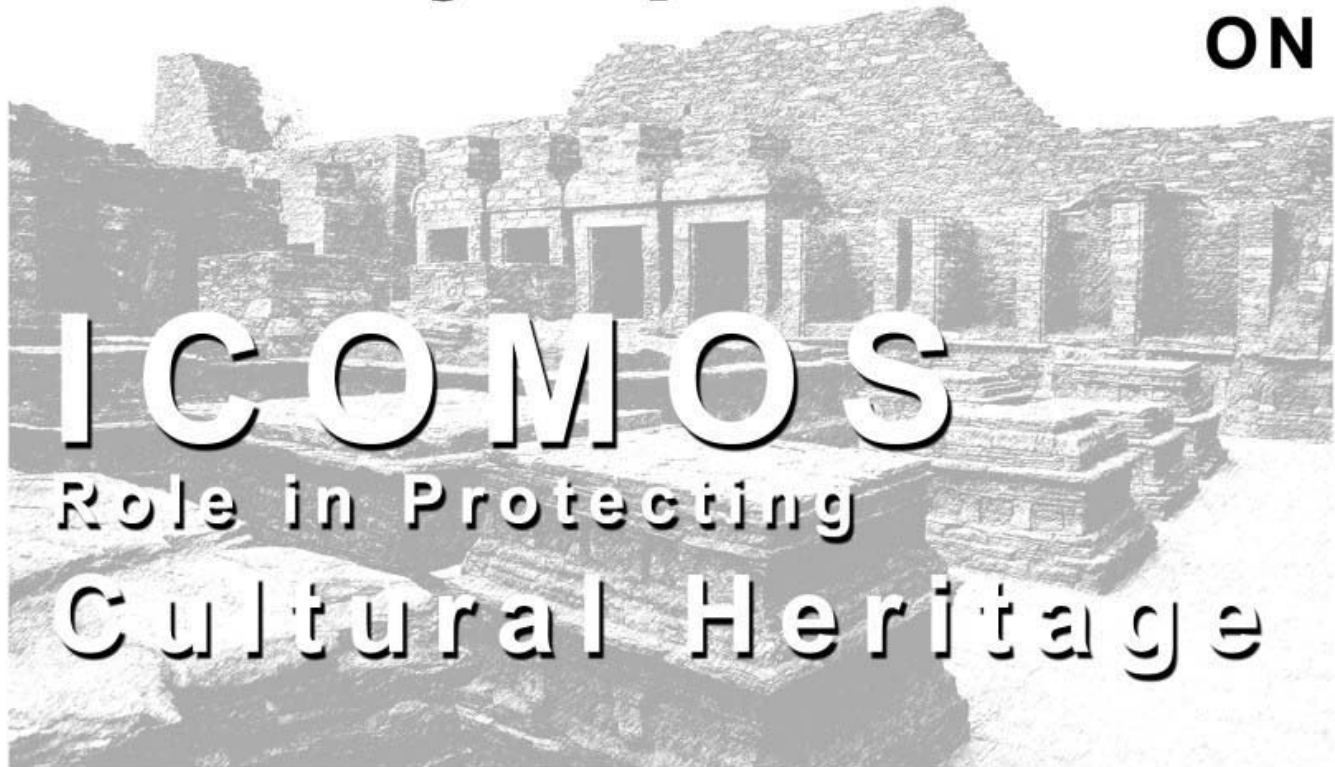


A LECTURE BY **Dr. Zeynep Gül UNAL** ON



Dr. Zeynep Gül UNAL is a Professor in the Restoration Department at the Yildiz Technical University Faculty of Architecture where she has been a faculty member since 1988 and currently running **Disaster Risk Management on Cultural Heritage** in Ph.D. Course and Restoration Project in Graduate Programme.

Dr. UNAL has been serving as Director of Yildiz Technical University Research Center for Preservation of Historical Heritage Ta-MIR and Vice Director of Yildiz Technical University International Center for Urban Studies - YTÜ ICUS. Dr. Unal is Board Member of **ICOMOS International/International Council on Monuments and Sites**, Secretary General of ICOMOS **ICORP/International Scientific Committee on Risk Preparedness**, founding chairperson ICORP Turkey. Dr. Unal also acted as a UNESCO Turkey WC Member of World Heritage Sites in Conflict Zones, Scientific Board Member of Diyarbakir Fortress and Hevsel Gardens Cultural Landscape.

She is also a member of GEA Urban Search and Rescue Group and participated many search and rescue operations and humanitarian assistance on response phase such as; Haiti, Ercis, Van Earth quakes, Bosnia and Herzegovina flood disasters.
