NED University Launches Ground-breaking Undergraduate Fellowship Programme Covering 100% Tuition for All Fresh Admissions and Current Students

Fellowship Details for Fresh Admissions:

Starting with the upcoming academic year, all newly admitted students will benefit from the fellowship programme based on their merit positions. The fellowships are divided as follows:

Jinnah Merit Fellowship: Top 50 students from each board will receive 100% tuition and examination fee coverage.

Iqbal Leadership Fellowship: Students ranked 51 to 100 will receive a 70% fellowship.

Jauhar Fellowship: Students ranked 151 to 225 will receive a 30% fellowship.

Liaquat Ali Khan Excellence Fellowship: Students ranked 226 to 325 will receive a 25% fellowship.

Fatima Jinnah Academic Fellowship: Students ranked 401 and beyond will receive a 20% fellowship.

These fellowships are allocated proportionately across various boards and categories, ensuring equitable access to this significant financial support. The fellowships will significantly reduce the financial burden on students. The fellowships are applicable on tuition and examinations fee, and the students shall pay any other fee components which are a part of admission process.

The list of eligible candidates for the fellowship programmes will be published on the NED University website alongside the merit list.

Continued Support for Current Students:

For students already enrolled, the fellowship programme extends beyond the first semester. The top three students in each programme per semester will be awarded fellowships based on their CGPA:

Jinnah Merit Fellowship: 100% tuition coverage for first position holders.

Iqbal Leadership Fellowship: 70% tuition coverage for second position holders.

Sir Syed Visionary Fellowship: 50% tuition coverage for third position holders.

Additionally, all remaining students with a CGPA above 2.0 will be eligible for the Jauhar Fellowship, which provides a 22% tuition reduction. Financial assistance is also available for students with a CGPA below 2.0, covering 15% of their tuition fees.

By naming the fellowships after national figures, the university aims to inspire students to follow in the footsteps of these illustrious personalities, contributing meaningfully to society and the nation.
