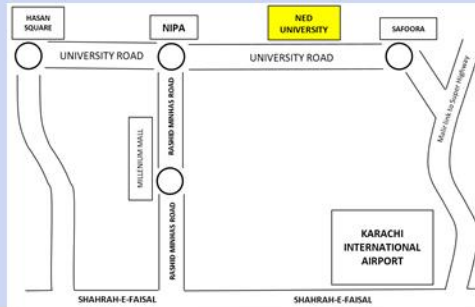

PROJECT EVALUATION CRITERIA

Degree of innovation	40%
Potential Impact on local industry and economy	20%
Readiness for commercialization (prototype, business plan)	30%
Presentation	10%
