NEDUET faculty will deliver lectures and training to build GDA staff capacity, especially for community-based projects.</li> <li>3. NEDUET may develop a training manual and conduct workshops/short courses for sustainable capacity building of GDA staff.</li> <li>4. NEDUET may advise GDA on adaptive reuse of heritage buildings in Gwadar in architecture and urban planning contexts.</li> <li>5. NEDUET may support GDA through technical reviews of urban engineering projects and guidance to engineers.</li> <li>6. NEDUET may help GDA design and run public awareness campaigns on conservation, heritage, and sustainability.</li> <li>7. GDA will facilitate NEDUET students, researchers, and faculty visiting Gwadar for study and research.</li> <li>8. GDA will support NEDUET students and researchers in academic and research activities through appropriate mechanisms.</li> <li>9. Both parties may co-organize national/international seminars and conferences on urban planning, sustainability, and engineering.</li> <li>10. Both parties may host competitions and hackathons where students propose solutions for Gwadar, with GDA providing data and resources.</li> <li>11.
