## Who we are

**Pakistan International Container Terminal Ltd (PICT)** is a state-of-the-art modern container terminal operating at berths 6-9, East Wharf, Karachi Port with a back-up area of 21 hectares. It has been designed to handle containerized cargo on International Standards. We are in the business of operations and management of common user container terminal at Karachi Port.

PICT is the only container terminal operator in Pakistan which is listed at the Pakistan Stock Exchange. It is the first port infrastructure project in Pakistan financed by International Finance Corporation (IFC) – the private sector arm of the World Bank. It is the first private sector project in Pakistan in which the OPEC Fund for International Development has participated as financier.

The journey dates back to 2002 where a container terminal was established to set a new trend of handling containers in Pakistan in order to become the most reliable port gateway of international trade. Incorporated in Pakistan as a private limited company in 2002, PICT was converted to an unquoted public limited company and a year later, listed on the Pakistan Stock Exchange Limited. By the end of the year 2012, with the acquisition of majority shares of the company, Global group International Container Terminal Services, Inc. (ICTSI) became the Parent Company of PICT. Our head office is located in Manila, Philippines.
