PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Panjwani-Hisaar Water Institute (PHWI) at NED University is a pioneering multidisciplinary institute established through collaboration between NED University, Panjwani Charitable Foundation, and Hisaar Foundation. Designed as Pakistan’s leading water institute, PHWI integrates engineering, social sciences, policy, and environmental perspectives to deliver innovative solutions in sustainable water management, climate resilience, and hydropower development. The “makeithappen” Internship Program offers recent graduates a unique hands-on opportunity to be part of building a world-class water institute from the ground up.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Recently graduated (2025 onwards) with a Bachelors or Master’s degree from NED University (any discipline).
- Preference will be given to candidates with background or strong interest in Water Supply & Sanitation, Environmental Studies, Coastal & Riverine Studies, Climate Change, Hydrology, Water Psychology, Eco-Systems & Nature Based Solutions Agriculture or related fields
- NED graduates will be given priority. Non-NED graduates from recognized universities are also eligible, subject to availability.
- Good written and verbal communication skills in English and Urdu along with proficiency in MS Office. Knowledge of AutoCAD, GIS, or hydrological modelling software is an advantage.
- Bring your own laptop.
- High level of commitment, initiative, creativity, and teamwork.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support academic, administrative, and research activities under the PHWI Commissioning Team.
- Assist in research, documentation, content development, event organization, data collection, and occasional field visits.
