Election of one Registered Graduates as Member on the Senate of NED University


In pursuance of Section 13(1)(x) to be read with Section 29(3)(b) of the NED University of Engineering & Technology Act, 1977 (as amended in 2018) and the provisions of the NED University of Engineering & Technology (Elections to the Senate and Syndicate) First Statutes, Election of One Registered Graduate to the Senate of the NED University is to be held in accordance with the Schedule notified as under:

1	Publication of Electoral Rolls and issuance of Nomination Papers	06-05-2025 (Tuesday)
2	Last date for Filing of Nomination Papers	12-05-2025 (Monday)
3	Scrutiny of Nomination Papers	15-05-2025 (Thursday)
4	Withdrawal of Candidature	26-05-2025 (Monday)
5	Final List of Candidates	03-06-2025 (Tuesday)
6	Polling	17-06-2025 (Tuesday) (09:00 hrs to 15:00 hrs without break)

- 2) One registered graduate is to be elected by such graduates whose names are included in the Register maintained by the Registrar for this purpose and finalized upto 31st December 2024.
- 3) The Electoral Rolls shall be open to inspection in the office of the Returning Officer (Registrar) during office hours. Copy of the Electoral Rolls can be obtained from the office of Returning Officer on payment of Rs. 1000/-.
- 4) Nomination forms may be obtained from the Returning Officer (Registrar) during office hours from 06-05-2025. The Last date for filing of Nomination Papers is 12-05-2025 till office hours in the office of the Returning Officer.

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- 5) The list of all nominations received upto the time and date specified above, shall be displayed on the Notice Boards in the Registrar's Office
- 6) The nomination papers shall be scrutinized by the Returning Officer in his office in the presence of persons attending the scrutiny and the list of valid nominations shall be displayed on the Notice Boards the next day.
- 7) A candidate whose name is included in the list of valid nominations may, by notice in writing signed by him and delivered to the Returning Officer, withdraw his candidature on the time and date specified above.
- 8) Final list of candidates shall be displayed on the Notice Boards on 03-06-2025.
- 9) Polling will take place in the University Auditorium on the date and time specified above.
- 10) Each contesting candidate may nominate one polling agent, who shall be a voter, and whose name shall be intimated in writing to the Returning Officer before the Polling starts.
- 11) The votes will be counted by the Returning Officer in the presence of the candidates or their authorized polling agents. The votes will be entered in the counting sheet, which will be signed by the Returning Officer and the candidates counting sheet, which will be signed by the Returning Officer and the candidates or their polling agents whereafter the results will be announced by the Returning Officer.
- 12) For casting of the vote every registered graduate shall be required to produce his original Registration Card and CNIC.
- 13) All voters who may be present at the time of closing of the polls at the polling station shall be eligible to cast their votes.
